
Covid-19 pandemic - its impact and implications for the economy 2<sup>nd</sup> (FINAL) CALL FOR BOOK CHAPTERS



We are cordially inviting **chapter submissions** to an edited book volume on the economic consequences of the pandemic. The tentative title is *Covid-19 pandemic - its impact and implications for the economy*. The book volume will be edited by Witold Nowiński, Jan Rymarczyk and Kazimierz Starzyk and published by the WSB University in Poznan Press (Poland). The book is scheduled for publication in 2022. It will appear in **electronic format** as **open access** publication. Due to support of WSB University in Poznan publication fees are waived. The editors and the publisher will undertake extensive efforts to include the book in international data bases.

We invite manuscripts falling within domains of business management and economics which either deal with direct consequences of the pandemic or, at least, provide clear implications for policy makers and/or companies stemming from the pandemic. We encourage submissions of empirical papers but conceptual or literature review manuscripts are also accepted.

## Submission guidelines

- 1. recommended manuscript length 4000-9000 words including references (we can be somewhat flexible if upper limit cannot be met),
- 2. referencing should follow APA Style,
- each chapter should have following structure: introduction, literature
  review/theoretical framework, methods, results, discussion and conclusions;
  deviations from this structure are acceptable in case of literature review or
  conceptual papers (please contact us in case of questions);
