

Authors' notes on the layout of manuscripts

The journal 'Blätter der Wohlfahrtspflege' is published according to the latest rules on German spelling. In any ambiguous cases, we follow Duden's recommendations.

To denote differences in gender in German words, please use *.

Contributions should not exceed 12,000 (up to a maximum of 16,000) characters including spaces and references.

The body text should be left-justified, without separations, and preceded by a short author's note, including their email address or website.

The title, which should be single-spaced if possible (possibly including a subheading), should be followed by a teaser of 3 to 6 lines.

Please use double chevrons (»...«) to indicate quotations marks; please use single chevrons (›...‹) to denote single quotation marks (for example, for quotations within quotations).

Footnotes should be avoided if possible. References should be included in the text in parentheses with the following information in the following order: author's name year, page numbers if applicable. Complete references should be inserted in the bibliography at the end of the text and should contain the following information in the following order:
